

Majority of Workers Plan to Work Past 65 but ...

Fifty-two percent of workers plan to work past age 65 or do not plan to retire, but expected retirement age differs across age ranges. More than half of workers in their Forties (52 percent) and Fifties (57 percent) expect to do so. A significantly higher proportion of workers in their Sixties and older (79 percent) plan to work or are already working past age 65 or do not plan to retire. In contrast, the majority of workers in their Twenties (58 percent) and Thirties (55 percent) expect to retire age 65 or sooner.
